
Calculator Policy

A non-graphing calculator with logarithmic and exponential capabilities is **required**. The **TI30 XIIS** (solar) or **TI30 XIIB** (battery) with a two-line display is preferred (pictured to the right).

Graphing calculators are **NOT** allowed on tests, on the Final Exam, or in the LSU Math Lab.

Calculators with symbolic notation or natural display capabilities, such as the TI-30XS Multiview, the TI-34 Multiview, the TI-36XPro, and the Casio 115ES Plus or 300ES Plus Natural Textbook Display series, are **NOT** allowed on tests, on the Final Exam, or in the LSU Math Lab.



Following are current examples of calculators NOT allowed in the LSU Math Lab or in the Testing Center:

Casio uses the description Natural Display. FX-115ES Plus FX-300ES Plus





HP uses the term **SmartCalc**.



Sharp uses the word WriteView.



TI sometimes uses the term MultiView.
